Meditech Expense

A team of four Meditech Expense specialists came to Delta on Wed Aug 31st to give a live demonstration to showcase Meditech's ambulatory and emergency physician solution. Providers were shown how with one touch on a mobile device they can view their schedule, retrieve and trend results, manage their patient's conditions, and process prescription requests.

A survey of the providers who attended was very positive. The providers have asked to see the program work in real time. Your Administrative team is working with Meditech to schedule that opportunity. Next, Meditech will meet with our hospital managers to view the different modules available for each hospital department.

We will continue to keep you updated on the progress of this mutually important decision.

New Pet / CT Scanner

The PET / CT scanner ordered in June is due to arrive in November. We will be bringing in a mobile CT scanner for two months so that we have the ability to manage emergent patients. (Mid-Oct through Dec)

The mobile CT scanner will be parked on the north side of the building and will be utilized as our second CT scanner while we are disassembling the old unit and the CT room is being upgraded for the new unit.

Medical Staff Bylaw Update - Your Vote Counts!

The Medical Executive Committee has updated the medical staff **OPPE/FPPE** (practice evaluation) process. Their goal was to improve our new physician orientation and proctoring practice. Your Chairs have also ensured that ongoing education and evaluation of our medical staff providers is consistent among all medical specialties.

The Focused Professional Practice Evaluation (FPPE), explained in the Medical Staff Credentialing Manual; Section V. has been updated and can be accessed on the hospital's intranet on the Medical Staff page; as well as on the Medical Staff website under Policies and Procedures.

We are asking for your approval to update our Medical Staff Bylaws to complete our new OPPE/FPPE process. A ballot will be in your mailboxes on Monday. Please return your ballot to the Medical Staff Office. We will announce the results at our **Annual Medical Staff meeting on Tue Nov 15th.**

Aug 2022 financials resulted in a net gain from operations of \$282,843.

YTD our net income is (\$1,501,872).

Medicare/Medicaid as a % for the month of August was 74.6%.

We received our first sales tax transfer last week in the amount of \$318K. This will be applied to September's financials. This will allow us to continue to reinvest in our human resources and the infrastructure and technology of our organization.

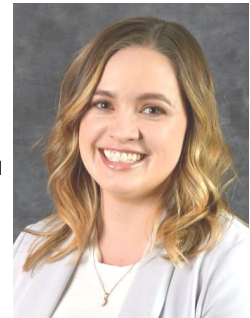

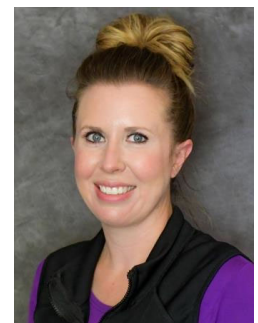
